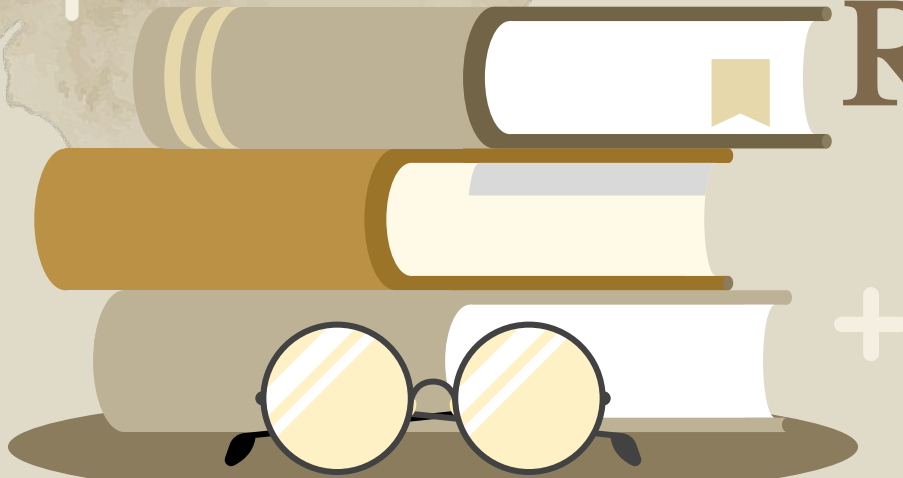

# What are some class options for Sophomores?

# New Courses to Consider for Sophomores

## SCS-3050 Forensics

### 0.5 Science Credit

Prerequisite: Algebra I & Biology

Apply scientific knowledge and principles to college, preserve and analyze evidence in a laboratory setting. Topics include entomology, forensic anthropology, serology and fingerprinting.

## SCH-3031/3032 Real World Science

### 1.0 Science Credit

Prerequisite: Biology

Real World Science will cover unique concepts of science. Topics such as nuclear chemistry, household chemistry, explored through real-world applications.

## SCE-3010 Earth Science

### 0.5 Science Credit

Prerequisite: Biology

Do you like rocks and dinosaurs? Do you want to learn about the Earth and its history? Earth Science covers the ever changing Earth, fossils, dinosaurs, rocks, minerals, and the oceans. Sign up for Earth science and learn more about our dynamic planet.

## CTC-3090 Computer Gaming & Design

### 0.5 Computer Science Credit

Computer Gaming and Design prepares students to design computer games by studying design, “the origin of game theory”, animation, artistic concepts, digital imaging, coding, scripting, multimedia production, and game play strategies. Advanced course topics include but are not limited to, level design, environment and 3D modeling, scene and set design, motion capture, and texture mapping.

## *Follow Advanced Honors Endorsements*

- 4 credits of English
- 3 credits of Social Studies
- 4 credits of Algebra or Higher Mathematics
- 4 credits of Science
- 1 credit of Fine Arts
- 2 credits of the following or a combination of the two:
  - Career and Technical Education Courses (CTE)
  - World Language
- .5 credit of Personal Finance or Economics
- .5 credit of Physical Education
- .5 credit of Health or Health Integration
- ACT score of 24 needed (28 exempts all criteria)
- No Final Grade below a "C"
- Minimum grade point average 3.0
