- Talk to your teachers for recommendations on courses
- Seek guidance from parents and guardians
- SPED talk to your case managers
- EL students will work with their EL teachers

- See your counselor if needed
- Register for classes directions on form
 - Put intentional thought into your selections
 - Change requests will be limited along with course openings/availability
- Need to have 16/16 units registered

What do Sophomore students take?

- ► Most 10th Graders will take:
 - English II LAE-3021 AND LAE-3022
 - Math (usually Geometry) MAG-3011 AND MAG-3012
 - Chemistry or Physics SCC-3011/3012 or SCP-3011/3012
 - World History SSH-3070 (semester class)
 - Consider Speech
 - CTE courses, Fine Arts, Computers, Business Course, Physical Education, etc...
 - Health?, World Geography?
 - Consider taking or continuing a World Language class
